

Dear Dads & Lads,

We will continue our “Pinnacle Moments” again this year. This is our time of a Rite of Passage for the Lads who will be 12 yrs of age or older within the year. You may do this either at 12 or 13 yrs old. While this is an optional activity, pinnacle moments can be a important memory for you and your son.

Pinnacle Moments is a special time for you & your son to mark or signify the changing relationship between the two of you, and commit to his continued growth as he moves toward manhood. We will do this ceremony at the campfire on Friday night.

We would encourage you to pray about this and talk to your son about this time before coming to camp. Also keep the following in mind:

- ◆ We would like the Lads to bring a toy or something else from their childhood that they don't mind parting with (they will be tossing them in the campfire).
- ◆ We would like the Dads to bring something that they will give to their sons as a right of passage maybe something passed down through the family, or whatever you feel appropriate to signify your affection for your son and pride in his journey in growing up. We would recommend that you keep this fairly inexpensive; something that was once yours would be especially meaningful. We will give you an opportunity to share with your son the gift's significance and/or anything else you would like to share.

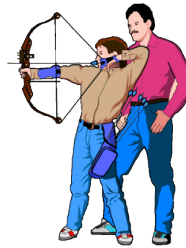
