

## **HORSE WRANGLER - JOB DESCRIPTION**

RESPONSIBLE TO: PROGRAM DIRECTOR

### RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Do the daily feeding and care of horses. Coordinate with the Program Director for weekend feeding of horses.
2. Maintain tack shed, horse barn, pasture and riding ring in good condition and appearance.
3. Keep riding equipment clean and in quality condition.
4. Make sure safety guidelines are strictly followed.
5. Coordinate the horse riding program with the use of several assistants and counselors.
6. Prepare daily and weekly lessons to teach campers.
7. Instruct the proper care and feeding of horses to the campers.
8. Instruct the proper techniques of saddling and riding horses.
9. Arrive at camp a week early to work with horses and become familiar with them.
10. Lead staff rides when appropriate.
11. Help in getting hay, feed, tack, and other supplies.
12. Inventory all equipment and supplies at beginning and end of summer. Make any requests for needed supplies to Program Director.
13. Move horses from one pasture to other and maintain safety and closure of fences/gates.
14. Assist in other areas when needed.
