HORSE WRANGLER - JOB DESCRIPTION

RESPONSIBLE TO: PROGRAM DIRECTOR

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. Do the daily feeding and care of horses. Coordinate with the Program Director for weekend feeding of horses.
- 2. Maintain tack shed, horse barn, pasture and riding ring in good condition and appearance.
- 3. Keep riding equipment clean and in quality condition.
- 4. Make sure safety guidelines are strictly followed.
- 5. Coordinate the horse riding program with the use of several assistants and counselors.
- 6. Prepare daily and weekly lessons to teach campers.
- 7. Instruct the proper care and feeding of horses to the campers.
- 8. Instruct the proper techniques of saddling and riding horses.
- 9. Arrive at camp a week early to work with horses and become familiar with them.
- 10. Lead staff rides when appropriate.
- 11. Help in getting hay, feed, tack, and other supplies.
- 12. Inventory all equipment and supplies at beginning and end of summer. Make any requests for needed supplies to Program Director.
- 13. Move horses from one pasture to other and maintain safety and closure of fences/gates.
- 14. Assist in other areas when needed.
