LIFEGUARD - JOB DESCRIPTION

RESPONSIBLE TO: PROGRAM DIRECTOR

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. Must have Lifeguard certification from a national organization (i.e.-Red Cross, YMCA)
- 2. Responsible for testing pool chemical balance & recording results. Report problems or increase chemical needs to the Pool Pesticide Applicator.
- 3. Maintain daily records for health department and any medical or accident reports.
- 4. Explain pool rules to campers and staff.
- 5. Conduct the swimming test for all campers and staff.
- 6. Supervise pool activities, following lifeguard procedures.
- 7. Coordinate instructional swimming classes and help instruct.
- 8. Be safety-conscious at all times, especially while on duty. Strictly enforce safety guidelines.
- 9. Keep pool supply room clean and organized.
- 10. Keep filter room closed. Keep pool gate locked when pool is closed.
- 11. Keep rescue equipment easily accessible & in working order.
- 12. Maintain physical & mental awareness by swimming laps regularly, practicing techniques, & reviewing emergency procedures & plans.
- 13. Keep pool clean by skimming, brushing, & vacuuming regularly.
- 14. Keep pool deck clean & free of obstructions and chairs and tables clean and organized
- 15. Keep lawn mowed, bushes trimmed, and gardens free of weeds.
- 16. Report any supply requests to Program Director.
- 17. Inventory all equipment & supplies at the beginning & end of summer.
- 18. Assist in other areas when needed.
